Guidelines for Community Outreach Recitals

Please peruse these guidelines before signing up your students for the Community Outreach Recital(s).

Qualifications

Students of all ages and level (any instrument) are welcome to participate.

Sign up procedure

- 1. Email the Community Outreach Director with name of student, age, level, instrument, musical selection, length of piece and composer.
- 2. Deadlines to sign up for the recital will be announced on the website and through email.
- 3. No participant fee.

General Guidelines

- 1. Each teacher can submit up to 3 students.
- 2. Time limit: the total amount of time allotted to each teacher's students is 10-12 minutes.
- 3. Dress recommendation girls: nice pants & top or dress/skirt, boys: nice pants & shirt. No tennis shoes.
- 4. Students performing a piece or a song requiring an accompaniment must provide their own accompanist.
- 5. Most styles are accepted. Try to avoid concertos as they can be lengthy.
- 6. Memorization is not required but strongly encouraged. Students must be well prepared. Unpolished performances are disrespectful to our audience and reflect poorly on our branch.

Additional Points

- 1. Seating is limited The first 4 rows are reserved for the retirement home residents.
- 2. Recitals will be approximately 60.
- 3. Call time for performers is 15 minutes.
